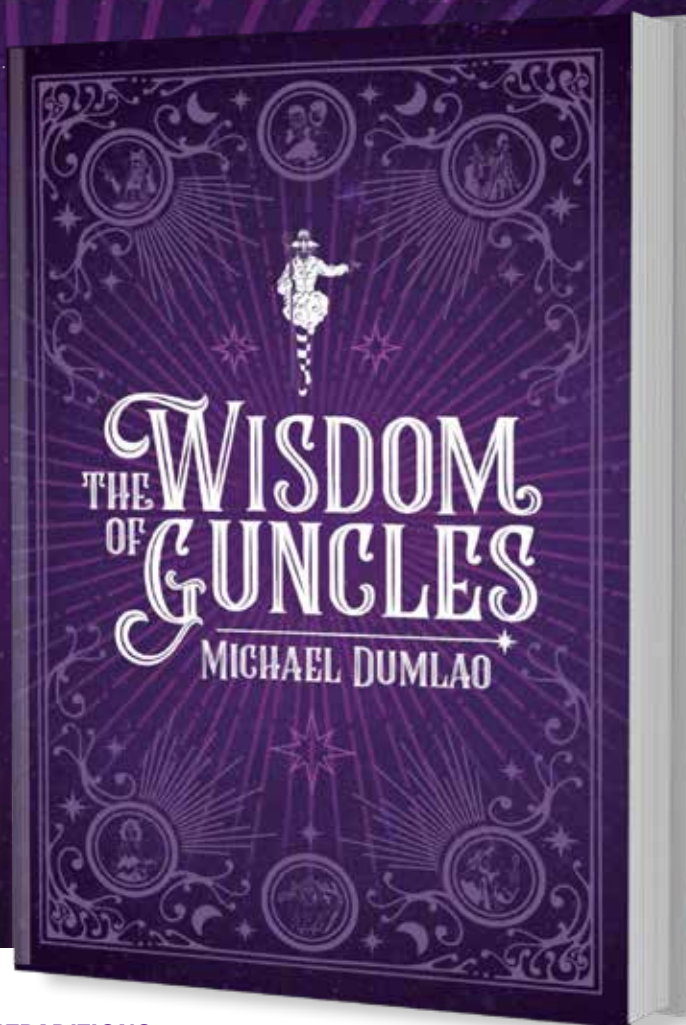

The Wisdom of Guncles is about queer people and our relationship with family – however we choose to define it. Featuring a diverse pantheon of gay uncles (“guncles”) and other queer mentors, these stories offer unique perspectives about life, love, and personal empowerment.

With each chapter, I examine what various LGBTQ+ experiences teach about disrupting norms, exploring identity, and creating chosen families that affirm one’s truth. Readers will ponder questions such as:

- How do I challenge and change traditions that hide those that are different?
- If I choose to never dim my light, will I become a beacon for others lost in the dark?
- How will recovering past stories and unsung heroes help us create a better future?
- How can I leave a space more welcoming than how I found it?

The Wisdom of Guncles shares ten powerful journeys, each bearing knowledge honed through struggle and triumph, on living with audacious authenticity and compassion.

While these narratives are unapologetically queer, they hold universal lessons about the human condition that, like all stories about family, are grounded in love.

The Wisdom of Guncles is about LGBTQ+ people and our relationship with family – however we choose to define it. Featuring a diverse, multinational pantheon of guncles (gay uncles) and other queer mentors, their stories offer powerful perspectives about life, love, and personal empowerment. From challenging traditions, to redefining family, to examining what the journey of coming out teaches us about self-discovery and transformation, this book is about the evolution, affirmation and resilience of identity.

Key stories and wisdoms include:

- **The Black Sheep** who challenges traditions and disrupts toxic behaviors to make families more inclusive and equitable.
- **The Alchemist** who dismantles gender norms and creates the safe-space they never had to embolden others to come out.
- **The Chameleon** who chooses to never dim their light after a lifetime of code-switching and becomes a beacon for family.
- **The Nerd** who finds the love, affirmation and support they need from their chosen families.
- **The Elder** who honors all secretly queer relatives who were hidden away and creates a world where we can all come into the light.

The **Audacious Authenticity Workshop** explores the critical role of the "black sheep" as entrepreneur and innovator, creating cultures of intentional inclusion, and the vital practice of making spaces more welcoming than how one finds them. Building on the themes from Dumlao's "The Wisdom of Guncles," the workshop invites introspection into how organizations can celebrate and nurture those that dare to defy and redefine norms and traditions to make places more inclusive and innovative.
